FIELDNOTES is inviting applications for its 2023 Development Grant Programme.

FIELDNOTES is an artist-run publishing project based in Newham in East London. FIELDNOTES produces a print journal twice a year and a public programme of workshops, radio broadcasts and events. The project aims to promote and support non-conforming creative practices that pioneer new cultural forms.

The Development Grant Programme will support four emerging artists and writers for a six-month period during which they will receive editorial and financial support in order to develop new text-based work. The aim is to support risk taking, to enable experimentation and allow for new poetic methodologies to develop across genres and media. The programme will take place between July and December 2023, with the purpose of offering a critical incubation period for projects pioneering new forms at the intersection of creative disciplines.

Each participant will receive a grant of £750 to cover their materials and time. Each participant will be allocated a mentor from the FIELDNOTES editorial team. Contact time will amount to 12 hours per participant to be structured either as monthly meetings or spread more flexibly throughout the period and across different channels of communication.

FIELDNOTES are actively seeking applications from underrepresented groups. Artists and writers who face cultural, social, physical or economic barriers in the arts are particularly encouraged to submit. Access riders are welcomed.

Eligibility:

This opportunity is open to all early-career UK-based artists and writers not enrolled in formal education at any point during 2023. It is aimed at those in situations of financial precarity who might otherwise not be able to dedicate time to producing new work, applicants are asked to answer in good faith as to whether they belong to this category. It is recommended that applicants get know FIELDNOTES publications (concessionary prices available in [our online shop](#)).

Application:

Applicants are asked to submit:

- a sample of previous work (max. 3000 words)
- a proposal (max. 500 words)
- a biographical note (max. 200 words)
- an equal opportunities form (as a separate attachment)
